Pope Speak

Pope Francis in his tweets, his daily sermons and his encyclical letters has introduced some new vocabulary to the Church' lexicon.

Dialogue: This term is used 23 time in five of his addresses during the 2015 visit to the United States. Dialogue doesn't mean giving up our identity as Catholic Christians. It means being open to understanding others.

The Devil: He has made a comeback in Papal writings. He is called Satan, the Accuser, the Evil One, the Father of Lies, the Ancient Serpent, the Tempter, the Seducer, the great Dragon, and the Enemy. Francis reminds us that he exists and is active. We have to learn from the Gospels how to do battle against him.

Field Hospital: This is a new and very apt image of the Church. As a Field Hospital, the Church continues to accompany all who suffer from the illness of Sin. It mercifully dispenses the medicine of Gospel's healing grace in the Sacraments throughout our lives.

Accompaniment: He write "Genuine spiritual accompaniment always begins and flourishes in the context of service to the mission of evangelization." He notes that we must take on the "smell of the sheep" we serve and help. We must be with them so that they are swilling to hear the voice of Good Shepherd.

Mercy: He has said that "a little mercy make the world a little less cold and more just." We need to understand properly the mercy of God our Father who is so patient with us. Mercy is the very heart and substance of the Gospel.

No gloves for candidates. Active duty military may wear formal dress uniforms. Policemen and firemen may wear their dress uniforms
